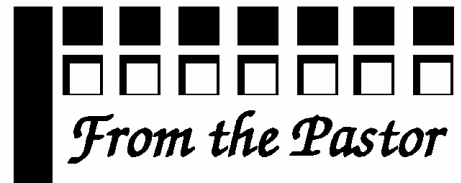

#### PARISH NURSE NOTE

During holiday time we cook more and should be aware of cooking safety. If you have a stovetop grease fire turn off the burner and put a lid on the pot to cut off oxygen to the fire. Let the pan cool before removing the lid. *NEVER* try to take a burning pan to the sink and *NEVER* use water on a grease fire. Use a fire extinguisher only if you know how; if you stand too close, you'll spread the flaming grease all over the kitchen. For an oven fire, turn off the oven and keep the oven door closed until the fire is out and the oven cools. *NEVER* leave the oven door open to heat the room. The oven can overheat and cause a fire.
