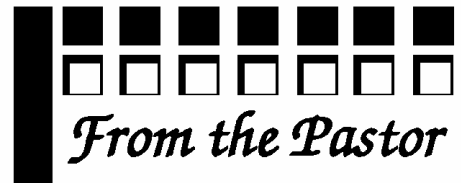

It also does not include donations to the annual Bishop’s Appeal, since this statement should come directly from the Bishop’s Appeal Office. Regular envelope usage, no matter what amount is contributed, provides a record of regular attendance which may be helpful when one is seeking a sponsor certificate or other verification of Mass participation. For the above reasons we strongly encourage our parishioners to use the Sunday collection envelopes.
