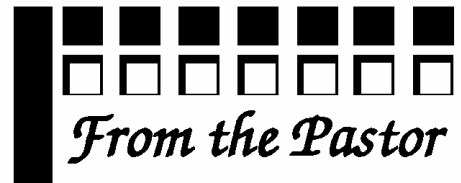

#### PARISH NURSE NOTE

Colorectal Cancer is a disease of the lower digestive tract. About 68,000 women and 67,000 men will be diagnosed with it this year. 29,000 women and 28,000 men will die of this disease. Advances in the detection and treatment of this cancer have made it very treatable if caught early. Who is at risk? Anyone is at risk for colorectal cancer. People with a family history of the disease or who have polyps in the colon or rectum, inflammatory bowel disease are at somewhat greater risk than the general population. Smoking or lack of exercise, obesity and diets high in fat and low in fiber may also put people at higher risk for colorectal cancer.
