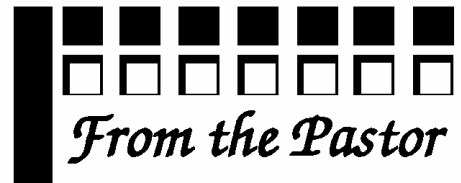

FLU SHOT CLINIC

This year’s Fly Shot clinic will be held at Seton Family Health Center, 1 Tallow Wood Drive, Clifton Park, N.Y. on Thursday, November 3rd from 8:00 to 10:30 AM. Seton Health nurses will be available to administer the immunizations. Recommendations are for persons 50 years or older and persons with health risks, chronic illness, immune system disorders, persons exposed to large groups and health care workers. Injections will not be given to children under 18 years of age at this clinic. Registration is required. St. Edward’s parishioners may call Addie Burkitt at 371-6511 to schedule an appointment. Injections will be covered under Medicare and most insurance plans. A second clinic will also be held at Seton Health on November 10th from 8:30 to 11:00 AM.
