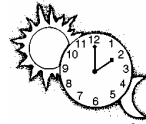
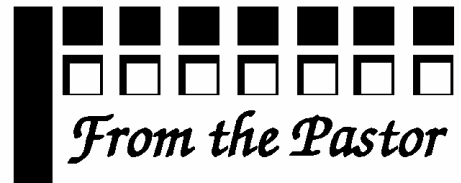

ANOIDING OF THE SICK

On Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup>, we will offer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick during the 9:00 AM Mass. This ancient rite reflects Jesus' concern for the sick. It invokes divine grace on those whose physical health, age or circumstance leaves them with a call upon the community to pray with and for them. This anointing is administered to the aged and the chronically ill, and often provides comfort for the emotionally distressed. Any member of the parish who by virtue of illness, pending surgery or emotional need, would be an apt recipient for this Sacrament. If you feel a special need to experience this anointing, you are most welcome to participate in this celebration.

**MAGNIFICAT**, a Catholic women's ministry, has been established in the Albany Diocese. The beautiful visitation scene from the Gospel of Luke is the inspiration for this woman-to-woman ministry, which adopts the name of Mary's hymn of praise and the spirit of the biblical encounter as its own. It is a private association of the Christian faithful, which is solidly Catholic and provides a point of unity for women in the Renewal, Marian movements, Cursillos, and Catholic women in general. An essential function of Magnificat is the Magnificat Meal, which offers women a chance to share and enjoy one another in an atmosphere of God's presence and love while providing a time for communal praise and worship. A highlight of the Meal is personal testimony where one woman shares her personal experience of God's action in her life. The meal ends with a time for healing prayer and/or confession.
