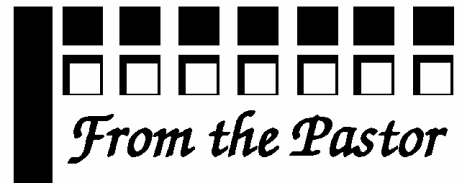

PARISH NURSE MINISTRY

Alzheimer's disease is the most common cause of dementia, which is the loss of intellectual and social abilities severe enough to interfere with daily functioning. It causes a steady decline in memory and mental abilities. Researchers are working on a cure for the disease and have made much progress. Treatments are available with help to improve the quality of life for people with the disease. They are studying new drugs and new treatments to block the progression of this complex disease.
