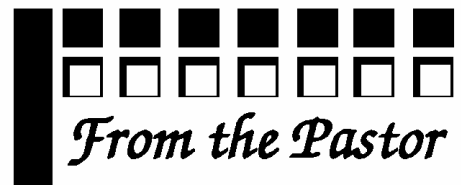

MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR DECEASED PARISHIONERS

Our annual Memorial Service for those members of the parish, who died since last year's service, will be held on Thursday, November 17th at 7:00 PM in the chapel. Letters of invitation have been sent to all the families of loved ones whose funeral was celebrated at St. Edward's Church. However, any family or individual who lost a loved one between November 1, 2004 and October 31, 2005, is invited to attend this service. If you plan to attend, we ask you to do several things. First, call the parish office (371-7372) and let us know the total number that will be coming to the service. Second, please bring a photo of the deceased person to be placed as part of the memorial. There is no restriction on the size of the photo. Third, you may bring a poem, verse or prayer to read at the service. There will also be an opportunity for individuals to share a few words on behalf of the family of the deceased. An informal reception will be held in the parish social hall immediately following the service. Your phone call to the parish will help us plan the service and the reception.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

We have found it necessary to institute a new policy with children attending the Sunday Children's Liturgy of the Word during the 9:00 or 10:30 AM Masses. It is unfortunate that we have a very small number of children who have become very disruptive during the liturgy time, creating a discipline problem for the catechists who are leading the program. Thankfully, most of the children who attend not only enjoy the session, but are able to learn more about their faith in the limited time available. However, the continued disruption takes away from the effectiveness of the lesson being taught. Effective immediately, any child that is creating a disturbance or simply "fooling around" will be asked to leave the session and return to church. The child will be accompanied by an adult. Unless the child can comply with the purpose of the instruction session, we suggest that he or she remain in church for Mass with the parents.
