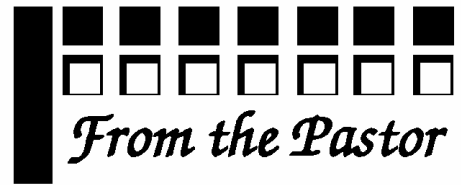

However, any family or individual who lost a loved one between November 1, 2004 and October 31, 2005, is invited to attend this service. If you plan to attend, we ask you to do several things. First, call the parish office (371-7372) and let us know the total number that will be coming to the service. Second, please bring a photo of the deceased person to be placed as part of the memorial. There is no restriction on the size of the photo. Third, you may bring a poem, verse or prayer to read at the service. There will also be an opportunity for individuals to share a few words on behalf of the family of the deceased. An informal reception will be held in the parish social hall immediately following the service. Your phone call to the parish will help us plan the service and the reception.
