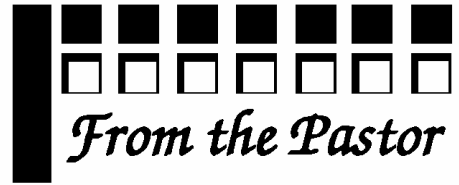

CELEBRATE THE VISIT OF THE MAGI

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, the visit of the Magi (Wise Men) to Bethlehem. They bring gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. Though the scriptures do not tell us the exact number of visitors, tradition lists the number of three. Their names are Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. In many countries in Europe, churches and homes mark the frame above the main entrance with chalk and the symbols (20 + C + M + B + 06). These initials remind us of the names of the three Kings set between the numerals of the current year (2006). They also stand for the Latin motto: "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" (May Christ bless this house). You may wish to continue this tradition in your home.
