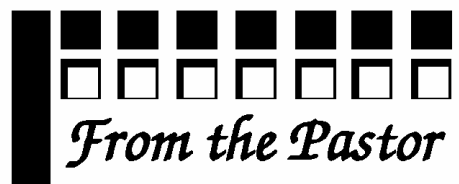

NEW STAFF POSITION

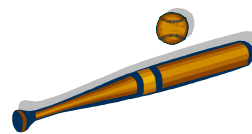

SACRIFICIAL GIVING AND STEWARDSHIP REPORT:

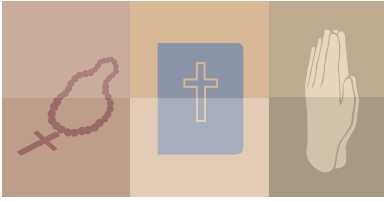
