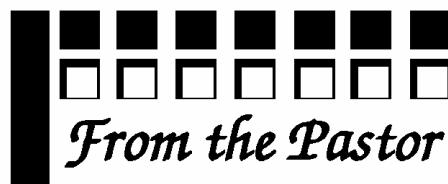

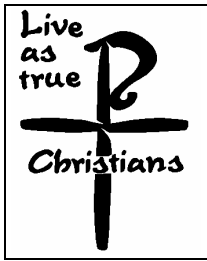


EUROPE 2007 TRIP
