DIOCESAN CEMETARY CLEANUP

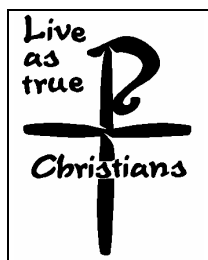

YOUTH MINISTRY SELLING BOSCOV'S COUPONS

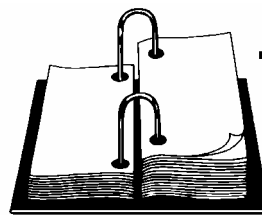
